The Provost and Executive Vice Chancellor allocated \$1 million in funding for a pilot Interim **COVID-19 Research Recovery Program (ICRRP)** as an investment in faculty research/creative activity in 2021-2022. The ICRRP aims to support recovery of research/creative activity that was significantly impacted by COVID-19 for assistant and associate rank faculty.

This is a call for the second round of applications due on **January 14, 2022**. The Provost has committed to continuing the program in 2022-2023.
