Dear Colleagues,

This is the final call for the Interim COVID-19 Research Recovery Program (ICRRP). Applications for the final award cycle are due on **January 9, 2023**.

The ICRRP is an opportunity for the campus to assist Academic Senate faculty members whose research or creative activity has been significantly impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic to recover from that loss. The program is available to Senate faculty of all ranks: assistant, associate, and full.

With the support of the Provost and Executive Vice Chancellor's Office, we funded 95 proposals in the 2021-22 academic year, and 38 proposals in Fall 2022.

**The deadline to submit an ICRRP proposal is January 9, 2023.**
