March 1, 2024 – March 15, 2024**

Members of the Irvine Division,

As directed by the divisional bylaws, the Committee on Committees hereby presents its slate of nominees for the Chair Elect-Secretary of the Division and vacancies on the Council on Academic Personnel and the Committee on Committees for the 2024-2025 academic year prior to the ballot, which will open on March 1, 2024 and close on March 15, 2024. The Committee also presents its slate of appointees to fill vacancies on all other Senate committees for the 2024-25 academic year. You may add a candidate to either slate by filling out the appropriate nomination petition form **no later than Thursday, February 29, 2024, 5:00 p.m. PT**. Please see below for details.

Slate of Nominees

The Chair Elect-Secretary of the Division and members of the Council on Academic Personnel and the Committee on Committees are elected by the Division. Please note that the Committee on Committees may update the slate prior to the March 1 opening of the ballot. In the event of any changes to the slate, the Committee on Committees will notify the Division.

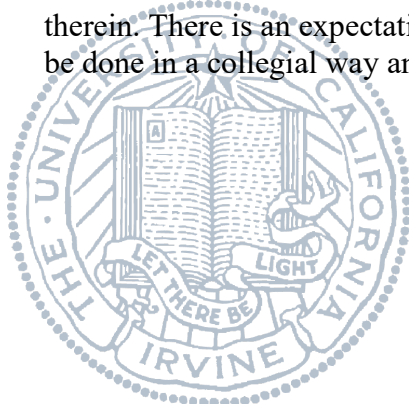
Slate of Appointees

These appointments are considered final unless the Committee on Committees receives a nominating petition form for appointed positions, also available on the [Senate website](#) (instructions are on the form). **If any petitions are received for an appointed position, the slate of appointees for that category becomes a slate of nominees and will be added to the ballot.**

The Committee on Committees strives to match faculty interests with committee vacancies and is pleased to report that 47 faculty were matched this year based on their responses to the Senate Service Interest Survey.

Voting instructions will be emailed to all members of the Irvine Division on March 1, 2024, the first day of the ballot. The election will be conducted by electronic vote.

All Senate members are bound by the Faculty Code of Conduct and the ethical principles embodied therein. There is an expectation that campaigning and public comments during the electoral process will be done in a collegial way and with openness and a fair opportunity for response.
